News from Forum Synergies projects

FS work group “Access to Land for Community Connected Farming” at Ashoka’s 30th anniversary

Ashoka Fellows are independent social entrepreneurs all around the world who are nominated and supported in their work by the Ashoka network. At the celebrations of the network’s 30th birthday from 16-22 June 2011 in Paris, FS and Terre de Liens were invited to moderate a thematic cluster day about "civic agriculture" as one of 11 European hot topics. Veronique Rioufol, Jérôme Deconinck and FS coordinator Titus Bahner moderated a group of 40 participants from a dozen countries, and the topic was presented to an auditory of about 1.000 Ashoka fellows and decision makers from around the world. Farmers Ecology

The 2nd « Ecologie Paysanne Europe » international workshop took place on Verdon Natural Park territory, in the Mediterranean region of Provence (France) on May 25 and 26th. It began with field visits on the main agro-ecosystems of the Park. The landscape interpretation and the visit of Valx and Felines areas, properties of the Conservatoire du Littoral (a land stewardship organisation), but managed by the Park, illustrated what were the prospects of valorisation of these spaces and how Farmer Ecological knowledge could contribute to it. In the peaceful *monastery* of Segries, the 20 participants coming from Romania, France and Spain exchanged on the progress of their local project, on the difficulties they were facing but also explained some good practices of work in order to inspire others. A first reflection on transmission of knowledge issue was also initiated thanks to the work initiated by a PhD student in collaboration with Geysler.
