Agro-Geological INNOVATION

Workshop on Agro-Ecological Innovation: In July 2012, Forum Synergies participated in the workshop on Agro-Ecological Innovation organized by IFOAM EU,

TP organics and ARC2020. Besides exchanges viewpoints on agro-ecological knowledge and innovation, we were presented Horizon 2020, the policy framework for research and innovation for the period 2014-2020 and its consequences for food and agriculture research. And also the European Innovation Partnerships, with operational groups which are supposed to close the gap between research and farming practices. Participants developed some ideas on future operational groups such as "Networks of farmers research clubs" or "Sharing knowledge about democratic governance of commons goods". On November 15th, 2012, the Agro-Ecological Innovation project will present its work and its recommendations to policy makers and the media.
