

DEMOCRACY - CIVIC DIALOGUE

FACTS

Democracy is at the heart of sustainable rural development

- Tools for democracy. The topic of participation and civic engagement is on the best way to become one of the most important democratic tools in order to influence policies in the future. On one hand, the on-going neglection of the people's longing for a sustainable development by some current policies is a multidimensional affront to human, social, cultural and environmental realities. On the other hand, more participation is enhanced by European and local institutions and bottom-up approaches are also raised by citizens empowering themselves.
- Rich in experiences. In many places of the world participation and civic engagement have already become reality. They have partially succeeded in influencing the political system or have at least reached a broader public, materialized in collective action. More organisations are focusing on governance processes, studying, accompanying and training on participative democracy, territorial dialogue, community-led development, selfmanagement.

- On a European level the work of the ARC during the last two years has shown quite impressively the importance of motivating, bringing together and consolidating civil society organizations in order to give them a voice to be heard.
- Forum Synergies has tackled the topic of participation and civic engagement from its beginning as it is one of our main philosophic principles (-> link to FS website: About FS, Philosophy). Apart from that we have given special attention to that topic within our thematic exchanges, namely the Lake Project, Access to Land, Rural Actors for Health, Farmers Ecology.
- Need for capacity building. When we really want the voice of people longing for a sustainable future to become heard and respected also on a political level there are two major challenges to be faced: make people believe that they can have the power for change and enable them to build up constructive dialogues with other stakeholders.

CIVIC DIALOGUE

What Forum Synergies wants to focus on

- Civic Dialogue. A new concept of how to approach the broad topic of democracy. Our intention is to deal with the topic of dialogue between different stakeholders when it aims at:
 - influencing policies which have a strong impact on territories with regard to agriculture, food, environment and social cohesion
 - contributing to the solution of local or regional issues of sustainable rural development
- Topics we will tackle: We will start a call for proposals so that Forum Synergies members and partners will have the opportunity to express the topics they feel to be crucial. Our frame is Europe in general, our focus will be mainly rural and ideally persons/groups who have experience in leading or analysing civic dialogue.

- We will concentrate our work on the following topics:
 - democracy within societies, states, the EU (dialogue between citizens and authorities to build or influence public policies)
 - civic engagement (cooperation between actors to build local projects; territorial dialogue)
 - dialogue and relationship building (environmental mediation; conflicts resolution in rural spaces)

Explicitly we see the challenge to tackle the youth, to think about ways of how to include minorities, of how to promote democratic processes in times of crisis, how to respect different cultures or how we can shorten the distances between grassroots and European level.

What we want to learn / achieve

- Gaining a deeper insight. We want to learn from success stories in order to better understand the mechanisms which lead to successful civic engagement.
- Capitalise the experience existing. During the last years Forum Synergies thematic exchange programmes have addressed the topic of civic engagement, participation and democratic processes from different angles. We wish to bring together all
- the lessons learned in order to create an added value on different levels from local to European.
- Spreading. Capacity building is one of the keycompetences of Forum Synergies. In order to make more success stories happen our vision is to create a kind of snowball effect where civil society organisations continue to build a broad alliance in order to promote sustainable rural development.

ACTIONS

 Inventory of organisations. In order to create a broader link Forum Synergies started building up an inventory of organizations working in different parts of Europe on participation issues, on territorial dialogue or environmental mediation.
